Pentecost Video Storytelling

Interactive Pinwheel Prayer

After watching the storytelling, create Pentecost pinwheels for each family member. See the included pinwheel links on the post.

The holy spirit is described as a wind rushing through the room the disciples were gathered in. By breathing to spin the pinwheel, kids can see the movement of the holy spirit as you pray.

For each fruit of the spirit (love, joy, peace, etc.)- breathe in the gift of the spirit and breath it out through the pinwheel and watch it spin.
